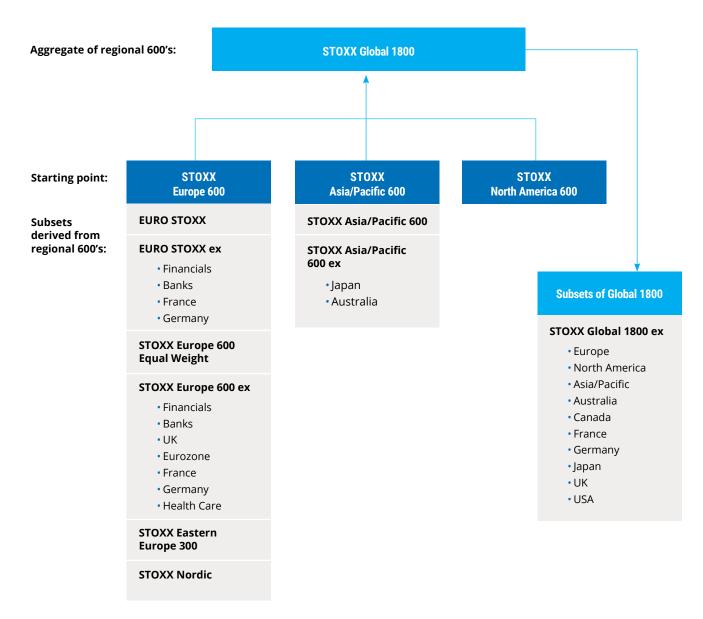


STOXX® GLOBAL 1800 INDEX

The index contains 600 European, 600 North American and 600 Asia/Pacific stocks represented, respectively, by the STOXX[®] Europe 600 Index, STOXX[®] North America 600 Index and STOXX[®] Asia/Pacific 600 Index.
